# Guide to navigating around the digital maps on a laptop or PC

### **Zooming in and out**

To enlarge the map you can either:

- Double click on the map and repeat till it is enlarged enough
- or click on plus button which is in the centre at the bottom of the screen

To zoom out again click on the minus button which is in the centre at the bottom of the screen.

## Moving around on the map

Place the cursor on an empty space on the map (it will look like a little hand) hold the left mouse button down - you will now have 'gripped' the map and you can move the map to the desired position.

### Searching

If you wish to search for a name or an address click on the continuous icon in the red title bar. Enter a name (surname followed by initials) or address.

Search results will be displayed as a list - click on the one you wish to view.

To return to the main menu click on icon displayed on the left of the red title bar

### Viewing the records on the map

You can click on any icon on the map and the record for that War Resister or Place will appear on the left of the screen.

To return to the main menu click on icon displayed on the left of the red title bar

To see the full list of War Resisters or Places click on the on the left, below the list name.

Click on the War Resister or Place record you wish to view. It will open for you to view. The location on the map will be shown by an icon in a white circle.

Use the arrow keys on your keyboard to navigate up and down the record (or the vertical slidebar on the right side of the record)

To view the images linked to a record of a War Resister or a Place go to the photo at the top. Click on the photo which will appear alone in a full screen. If there is more than one image you can click on the arrows

to the right and south back to the left to view them in turn.

To return to the main record click on in the top left corner

To return to the main menu click on icon displayed on the left of the red title bar

To collapse the list click on icon to the left, below the name of the list.
